ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR.

Dated Shillong, the 1st July, 1996.

No. ERTS(T)108/79/408 - In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 6 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Governor of Meghalaya, in consultation with the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council is pleased to entrust to that Council its functions to collect the tax under the Meghalaya Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation Act (Assam Act VI of 1947 as adapted and amended by Meghalaya from time to time with effect from the assessment year 1996- 97 under the conditions here in after appearing and until further orders.

2. The Tax shall be collected by the Council through its Officers in the areas falling within the Jurisdiction of the Autonomous District of Khasi Hills and not in those areas falling within the Cantonment and the other normal areas of Shillong.

3. The collection of the tax shall be on the basis of the place of work or business address of the assessee concerned.

4. The tax so collected shall form part of the revenue of the Council and shall not be shared with the State Government.
